

OFFICIAL RULES – 36th Annual ABAS Golf Invitational

Please Appreciate Our Tournament Donors (See Reverse)

The following rules are designed with your enjoyment in mind. We would like to keep a good *pace of play* and all finish about the same time for the luncheon.

SCRAMBLE FORMAT:

- Each player hits a tee shot; the team selects the “best” shot of the four, and each player hits the next (second) shot from there; continue this process until the ball is holed. Write down the number of strokes on the scorecard so we can add up your total number of strokes. (Please do not write a +/- number in relation to par.)
- Balls may be placed within one club length of the location (no closer to the hole) of the selected shot when off the green, and within 2" when on the green. If the selected shot is in the rough or sand bunker, you must play (within a club length) in the rough or sand bunker. Usual rules apply to water penalty areas.
- **Gimmes! - pick-up** if the putt is within length of your putter grip and add 1 stroke.
- **At least 2 drives must be used from each player.** Mark the scorecard with an “x” for the player whose drive was used for the hole. (Scorecard must show 2xs per player.)
- **PUTTS and PICK-UP RULE - Important Note: There is a 3 putt maximum. Pick up after 2 putts and add 1 stroke. Additionally, if you are lying BOGEY, STOP, pick-up and add 1 stroke. TWO (2) over par (double bogey) is the maximum score.** Following these rules should help the with the pace of play.

MEN HIT FROM 3 OAK TEES / WOMEN HIT FROM 2 OAK TEES*
*1 OAK TEES on PAR 5s

PLEASE DO NOT LET THE TEAM IN FRONT GET FAR AHEAD—KEEP UP WITH THEM.
Hit as soon as they are out of range. **Play “READY GOLF.”**

MULLYS: A Mulligan may be used for any shot redo, **EXCEPT** redo can’t count for game hole.
Purchase mulligans at check-in: \$5 each or 5 for \$20

ABAS GAME HOLES (CHARITABLE DONATION REQUIRED TO PLAY - \$20 PER FOURSOME):

Holes #6 & #12 “Closest to the Pin” (Men and Women - Must be on the green)
You may play the Barons Free Throw hole and apply the results to your score

Awards luncheon follows: 1st 2nd and 3rd prizes in 3 Flights!

PLEASE TURN IN YOUR SCORE CARD ASAP AT THE LUNCHEON

In case of ties, winners will be determined by a card off: lowest back 9, 6, or 3 holes; 18th hole
