OFFICIAL RULES – 37th Annual ABAS Golf Invitational

😊 The following rules are designed with your playing pleasure in mind. We would like to keep a *good pace of play so everyone can finish about the same time for lunch.* 😊

Instructions for Safe Scramble – Please Read Carefully

- Haggin Oaks Golf Course is where we play. Arrive early and hit some range balls (included), if you like. Shotgun start is at 8:00 am so **please be in your carts and ready to go by 7:45 am.**
- Men tee off from 3 Oak Tees / Women tee off from 2 Oak Tees (1 Oak Tees on Par 5s). Each player hits a tee shot. The team selects the “best” shot of the group. Each player hits the next (second) shot from there. **Have fun!** Continue this process until the ball is either holed or picked up. Write down the number of strokes on the scorecard so we can add up your total number of strokes. (We are not really interested in a +/- number in relation to par.)
- Balls may be placed within one club length of the location of the selected shot when off the green and within 2" when on the green—but never ever closer to the hole. If the selected shot is in the rough or sand bunker, you must play (within a club length) from the rough or sand bunker. Usual and customary rules apply to water penalty areas.
- At least 2 drives must be used from each player. Please mark your scorecard with an “x” for the player whose drive was used for the hole.
- Gimmes – Pick up your ball if the putt is within the length of your putter grip and add 1 stroke.
- Maximum Putts and Maximum Scores – We will enforce a 3-putt maximum. Pick up your ball after 2 putts and add 1 stroke. The absolute maximum score we will allow any team is two over par double bogey (per hole). If you are lying bogey: stop, look, listen, and pick up your ball and add 1 stroke. **And remember, you are having fun.**
- Note: *If you don't see the foursome ahead, you might be playing slow.*
- Mulligans – Purchase your Mulligans at check-in: \$5 each or 5 for \$20. A Mulligan may be used as a “do-over” (who ever said there are no second chances in life) on any shot except a closest to the pin shot.

ABAS GAME HOLES ARE #6 AND #12 – Closest to the Pin (on the green)
(A charitable donation is required to play - \$20 per foursome)
