OFFICIAL RULES – 38th Annual ABAS Golf Invitational
September 27, 2026 – Wildhorse Golf Club – Davis CA

😊 The following rules are designed with your playing enjoyment in mind. We would like to keep a good pace of play so everyone can finish about the same time for lunch. 😊

Instructions for Safe Scramble – Please Read Carefully

- Arrive early and hit some range balls (included, opens first light), if you like. **Check-in begins at 7:30. Please be in your carts, ready to go by 8:15. Shotgun start at 8:30.** Men tee off from **WHITE**/Women tee off from **GOLD**/Immediate past champions tee off from **BLACK**.
- Each player hits a tee shot. The team selects the “best” shot of the group. Each player hits the next (second) shot from there. Continue this process until the ball is either holed or picked up. **HAVE FUN!** Please write down the number of strokes per hole on the scorecard so we can add up your total number of strokes. (We are not interested in a +/- number in relation to par.)
- Balls may be placed within one club length of the location of the selected shot when off the green and within 2" when on the green—but never, ever closer to the hole. If the selected shot is in the rough or sand bunker, you must play (within a club length) from the rough or sand bunker. Usual and customary rules apply to water penalty areas.
- At least 2 drives must be used from each player. Please mark your scorecard with an “x” for the player whose drive was used for the hole.
- **GIMMIES** – Pick up your ball if the putt is within length of your putter grip and add 1 stroke.
- Maximum Putts and Maximum Scores – We will enforce a 3-putt maximum. Pick up your ball after 2 putts and add 1 stroke. The absolute maximum score we will allow any team is two over par double bogey (per hole). If you are lying bogey: stop, look, listen, pick up your ball and add 1 stroke. **And remember, you are having fun.**
- **NOTE:** *If you don't see the foursome ahead, you might be playing slow.*
- Mulligans – Purchase your Mulligans at check-in: \$5 each or 5 for \$20. A Mulligan may be used as a “do-over” (yes, there are second chances in life) on any shot except a game hole shot.

ABAS GAME HOLES ARE #4 (free throw) AND #12 (closest to pin, on the green)

Closest to Pin Prizes for Men & Women, 1st and 2nd places
